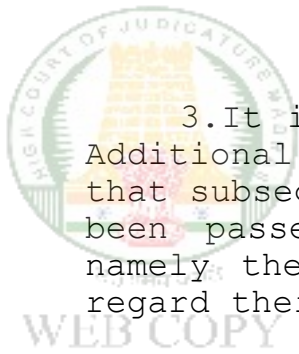

**ORDER**

This writ petition has been filed challenging the impugned enquiry notice, dated 02.03.2022, calling the petitioners for enquiry in respect of the complaint given by the third and fourth respondents, seeking for cancellation of the registered documents, which are standing in the name of the petitioners.

3.It is now brought to the notice of this Court by the learned Additional Government Pleader, appearing for the respondents 1 and 2 that subsequent to the issuance of enquiry notice, final orders have been passed by the first respondent, directing the complainant namely the respondents 3 and 4 to approach the civil Court with regard their grievance.

4.Since final orders are passed, no further orders need to be passed by this Court in this writ petition as the prayer sought for by the petitioner has been achieved.

5.In terms of the submissions made by the learned Additional Government Pleader appearing for the respondents 1 and 2 and in terms of the order, dated 24.03.2022, passed by the first respondent, this writ petition is disposed of. No costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition is closed.
