2.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor submitted that the rival party also sought for permission to conduct cultural programme on 28.03.2022. Already there was dispute between the petitioner and rival party, in which, two FIRs have been registered on the file of the second respondent.

3.Therefore, the request made by the petitioner cannot be considered at this stage and this petition is devoid of merits.



4. Accordingly, this Writ Petition is dismissed. No costs. However, the petitioner is at liberty to approach the second respondent, along with the rival party and seek permission to celebrate the festival.
