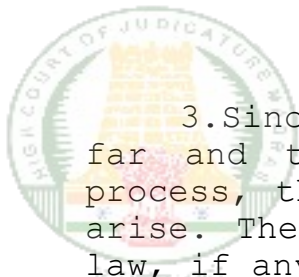
PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

**PRAYER :-** For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No. not known of 2022 on the file of the respondent Police.

**ORDER :** The Court made the following order :-

The petitioners, who seek anticipatory bail, are facing charges under Section 498A IPC in Crime No.Not known of 2022 on the file of the respondent police.

2.The learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) appearing for the 1<sup>st</sup> respondent submits that so far no case has been registered against the petitioners and only the petition enquiry is pending. He would further submit that it is a dispute between the husband and wife.



3. Since no case has been registered against the petitioner so far and the respondent police are undertaking the conciliation process, the question of granting anticipatory bail to them may not arise. The petitioners can work out their remedy in accordance with law, if any trouble arises during the course of investigation.

4. With the aforesaid liberty, this Criminal Original Petition is disposed of.
