3. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent would submit that the facts of the case are similar to the facts covered under the Judgment referred above.

6.The facts of this case is similar to the facts covered by the Judgment of this Court reported in **2018 2 LW (Cr1) 606 [Jeevanandham and others vs. The Inspector of Police Velayuthampalayam Police Station, Karur District] dated 20.09.2018** and in case of **Sri Raja vs Inspector of Police, Sivakasi Town Police Station Virudhunagar District and other** in batch of cases in **Crl.O.P(MD) No.7922 of 2019 dated 30.08.2019**. Accordingly, the proceedings in **STC.No.11198 of 2017** on the file of the Judicial Magistrate, Theni is hereby quashed insofar as the petitioners alone and the Criminal Original Petition is allowed. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition is closed.
