Prayer in WP(MD). 12958/ 2020 :

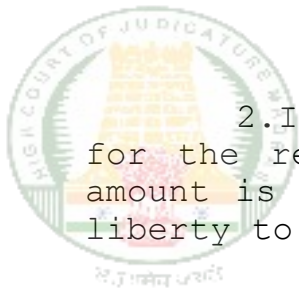
