2.Heard the learned counsel appearing on either side and perused the materials placed before this Court.

3.Accepting the reasons stated in the accompanying affidavit filed in support of this Petition and on being satisfied with the same, this Petition is allowed and the Petitioners are permitted to withdraw a sum of Rs.5 lakhs with proportionate accrued interest and costs as per the ratio of apportionment made by the Tribunal.
