Prayer : Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court to issue a Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondents to settle a sum of Rs.16,450/- towards the payment of Post Retirement Benefits Scheme amount, together with interest at the rate of 6% p.a. payable to the petitioner from the date of his retirement i.e. 30.06.2018 and all other attendant benefits to him within the stipulated period.

ORDER

The limited prayer sought for in the present Writ Petition is for disbursal of sum of Rs.16,450/- towards Post Retirement Benefits Scheme as well as for interest on the belated payment of the benefits.

When the petitioner herein had made an application under the Right to Information Act for details of his entitlement for the Post Retirement Benefits Scheme, the second respondent herein, through an order dated 01.12.2020, had replied stating that the petitioner is entitled for a sum of Rs.16,450/- till 30.06.2018. Admittedly, the aforesaid sum has not been paid to the petitioner at the time of his retirement on 30.06.2018.

3. In the light of the information supplied by the second respondent herein, there shall be a direction to the second respondent to consider the petitioner's representation dated
