ORDER

3.Heard the learned Counsel appearing for the petitioner as well as the learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondents 1 and 2.

4.Considering the above, the second respondent is directed to consider the voracity of the allegations and accordingly, register a FIR as against the accused persons within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of the order.

5.With the above direction, the writ petition stands disposed of. No costs.
