No costs.

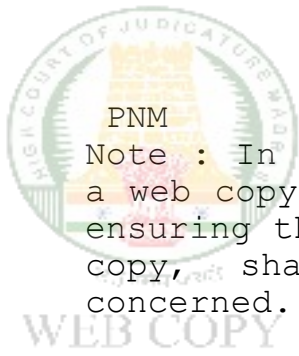
