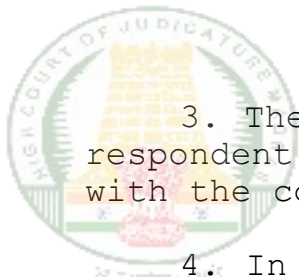
Prayer in Crl A(MD)No. 225 OF 2021:
