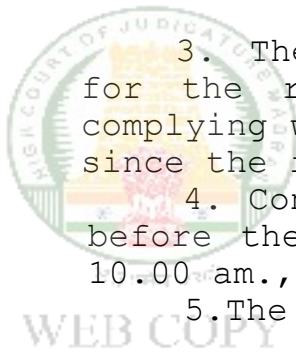
Prayer:- CRL OP(MD)838 of 2022
