PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.336 of 2021 on the file of the respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner/Sole Accused, apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offence punishable under Sections 294(b), 427 and 506(i) I.P.C, in Crime No.336 of 2021 on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that due to property dispute between the parties, on 22.06.2021, the petitioner went to the de-facto complainant's house, abused him in filthy language and threatened him with dire consequences. Hence, the complaint.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is the son of the de-facto complainant, he is innocent and he has been falsely implicated in this case.



4.The learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) for the respondent police submitted that there is a property dispute between the father and son and the petitioner is having no previous case.

5.Considering the nature of offence, the overt act attributed against the petitioner and the petitioner is not having any bad antecedents, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

6.Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is allowed and petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance, before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Vadipatti, on condition that the petitioner shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m. until further orders. The petitioner shall comply with the condition stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

7.The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
