Prayer in Crl.MP(MD)No.4730 of 2021 :- Criminal Miscellaneous Petition filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C., to relax the condition imposed by this Hon'ble Court in Crl.MP.(MD)No.505/2021 in Crl.A.(MD)No.451/2021 dt.24.01.2022 on the file of this Hon'ble Court and thus render justice.

ORDER:- This Criminal Miscellaneous Petition coming on for orders on this day and upon perusing the petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Mr.E.Mareeskumar, Advocate for the Petitioner and of M/s.M.Aasha, Government Advocate for the 1st & 2nd Respondents, this Court made the following order:-



This petition has been filed to relax the condition imposed on the petitioner in Crl.M.P(MD)No.505 of 2021 in Crl.A.(MD).451 of 2021, dated 24.01.2022.

2. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner is complying with the condition regularly. Hence, he prayed for relaxation of the said condition.

3.The learned Government Advocate(Crl.Side) appearing for the respondent would submit that the petitioner is regularly complying with the condition.

4.In the light of the above submission, the condition imposed on the petitioner in Crl.M.P(MD)No.505 of 2021 in Crl.A.(MD)No.451 of 2021, dated 24.01.2022 is modified to the effect that the petitioner shall appear before the concerned Police Station at 10.30 a.m., on the first working day of every month, till the disposal of the appeal.

5.Accordingly, this Petition is modified.
