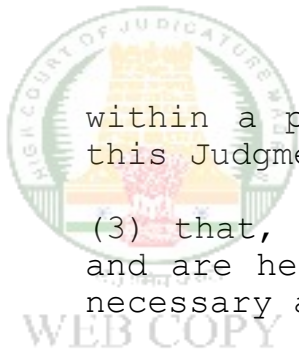

DECREE:-

This Civil Miscellaneous Appeal having come up for final hearing on this date, upon perusing the grounds of Appeal, the award of the Tribunal and the material papers to the Appeal and upon hearing the arguments of MR.P.PRABHAKARAN, Advocate for the Appellant and of MR.VINOTH FOR MR.M.SARAVANAN, Advocate for the Respondents and by virtue of the interim order granted by this Court dated 07.03.2019, the Appellant Transport Corporation has already deposited 50% of the award amount, this Court doth order and decree as follows:-

(4) that, there be no costs in this Civil Miscellaneous Appeal.
