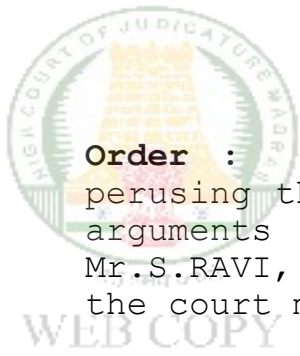

Prayer in CRL MP(MD). 2851/ 2021 :

To Suspend the sentence imposed in Judgment dt.17.2.2020 in SC.no.87 of 2016 on the file of the Mahila Fast Track Court, Theni and enlarge him on bail pending disposal of the instant Criminal Appeal.

3. This petition is allowed and the condition regarding the appearance of the respondent police on every Monday is modified and the petitioner is directed to appear before the Trial Court on the first working day of every month at 10.30 a.m., until further orders.
