2.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondents police submitted that while celebrating festival at Arulmighu Sri Nalla Muthu Mariamman Temple at Vairavapuram Village, Karaikudi taluk, Sivagangai District, there was dispute between two groups and the second respondent has registered three cases, against the petitioner group and rival group. If any permission is granted to conduct Adal Padal programme on 15.04.2022, there will be law and order between two groups.
