Accordingly, the proceedings in CC No.174 of 2013 on the file of the Judicial Magistrate No.II, Dindigul is hereby quashed insofar as the petitioners alone and the Criminal Original Petition is allowed. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petitions are closed.
