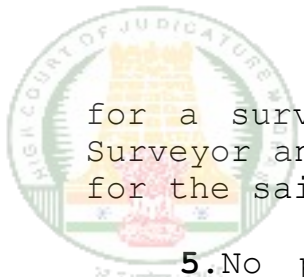
ORDER

This writ petition has been filed for a Mandamus seeking for a direction to the 1st and 2nd respondents to survey the lands in survey numbers 1/1, 1/2A, 1/2C, 32/2A, 32/2B, 32/2C, 32/2D, 32/2E & 32/2F, situated in Pusalpuram Village, Peraiyur Taluk, Madurai District, by considering the application of the petitioner, dated 03.02.2022, within a time frame to be fixed by this Court.

2.The petitioner has submitted a representation to the respondents on 03.02.2022 seeking for survey and demarcation of boundaries in respect of the aforementioned property, which she claims that it belongs to her absolutely. Since the said representation has not been considered till date, this writ petition has been filed.

3.Heard Mr.K.Jeyamohan, learned Counsel for the writ petitioner and Mr.M.Lingadurai, learned Special Government Pleader, who accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

4.The petitioner has produced documents in support of her case that she is the owner of the aforementioned property. She has sought



for a survey and fixation of boundaries by the appointment of a Surveyor and the petitioner has given a representation on 03.02.2022 for the said purpose.

5.No prejudice would be caused to the respondents, if the representation of the petitioner dated 03.02.2022 is considered on merits and in accordance with law, after hearing the petitioner as well as the rival claimants, if any.

6.Accordingly, this Court directs the respondents 1 and 2 to survey and fix the boundaries in the petitioner's land in survey numbers 1/1, 1/2A, 1/2C, 32/2A, 32/2B, 32/2C, 32/2D, 32/2E & 32/2F, situated in Pusalpuram Village, Peraiyur Taluk, Madurai District, after giving notice to the petitioner and rival claimants, if any, within a period of twelve [12] weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

7.With the above direction, this Writ Petition stands disposed of. There shall be no order as to costs.
