PETITION FOR BAIL Under Sec.439 of Cr.P.C.

PRAYER :-

For Bail in Crime No.291 of 2022 on the file of the Respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner/A.1, who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 24.03.2022 for the offences punishable under Sections 363, 366, 376(i) and 506(ii) IPC, in Crime No.291 of 2022, on the file of the respondent police, seeks bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner had threatened the de-facto complainant by stating that if she failed to marry him, he would kill her brother and thereafter, he had physical relationship with her. Hence, the complaint.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner is innocent person and he has not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution.



4.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor would submit that in the statement recorded under Section 164 Cr.P.C., the de-facto complainant has narrated the entire incident. He would further submit that the investigation is pending.

5.Considering the seriousness and gravity of the offence alleged and also the fact that the investigation is pending and also taking note of the statement under Section 164 of Cr.P.C. given by the de-facto complainant, this Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

5.Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is dismissed.
