PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.Not known of 2022 on the
file of the Respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioners, who seek anticipatory bail, are facing
charges under Sections 294(b) and 506 (ii) of IPC.

2.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submits
that because of the previous complaint made by the 1st
petitioner/father against his own son, who is the husband of the
defacto complainant, the wife of the son has given a complaint, upon
which a case has been conducted.
