The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the prayer in the petition has become infructuous.

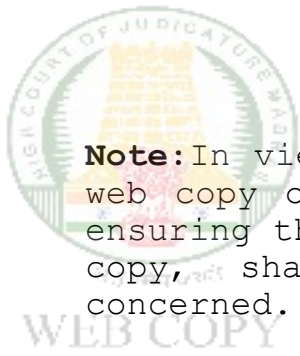
2. In view of the above submission, this Criminal Original Petition is dismissed as infructuous. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition is closed.
