Prayer in CONT P(MD)No.SR5124 of 2022:-

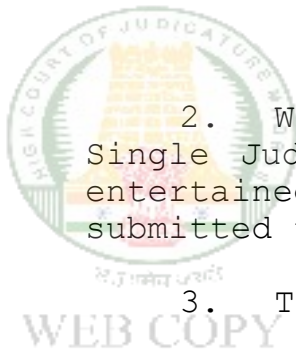
