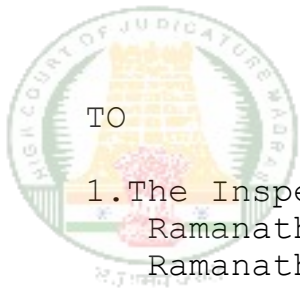
3.With the above said liberty, this Criminal Original Petition is dismissed.
