Prayer in CRL MP(MD) . No.5237 of 2022 :-

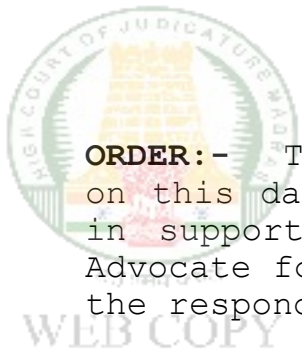

3. The learned Government Advocate(Crl.Side) appearing for the respondent would submit that the petitioner is regularly complying with the condition.

In the light of the above submission, the condition imposed on the petitioner in Crl.M.P(MD) No.7631 of 2021 in Crl.A(MD)No.400 of 2021, dated 03.12.2021 is modified to the effect that the petitioner shall appear before the trial Court once in a month i.e., on the first working day of every English calendar month at 10.30 a.m., till the disposal of the Crl.A.(MD) No.400 of 2021.

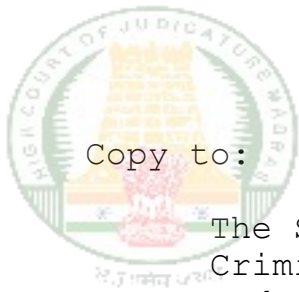
