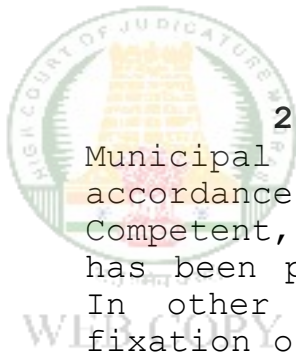

The show cause notice regarding proposed re-fixation and recovery of excess pay is under challenge in the present writ petition.



2. The petitioner was appointed in the fourth respondent - Municipal Corporation as unskilled employee. The pay was fixed in accordance with the Government Orders in force. The Authorities Competent, based on the audit objections, found that excess amount has been paid to the petitioner due to erroneous fixation of pay. In other words, the Audit parties raised objections regarding fixation of pay. Thus, the impugned show cause notice was issued to the petitioner asking him to submit his objections within a period of five days. Instead of submitting his objections, the petitioner has chosen to file the present writ petition.

3. This Court is of the considered opinion that no writ against a show cause notice needs to be entertained in a routine manner by the High Court. Once a show cause notice has been issued regarding wrong fixation of pay, then the petitioner has to submit his objections, if any, along with documents. Contrarily, writ petition cannot be entertained for adjudication of the issue, as the same is to be done by the Authority Competent at the first instance with reference to the documents and evidences made available.

4. In such view of the matter, the petitioner is at liberty to file his objections, if any, along with documents, within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order and on receipt of any such objections from the petitioner, the respondents are directed to consider the same on merits and in accordance with law and pass appropriate orders as expeditiously as possible.

5. With the above directions, the writ petition is disposed of. No costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petitions are closed.
