2. This is the second petition. This Court by an earlier order dated 30.11.2021, taking into consideration the seriousness of



offence committed by the appellant, dismissed the petition filed by the appellant to suspend the sentence.

3. Taking into consideration the fact that there is no change in facts and circumstances of the case and also taking into consideration the serious offence committed by the appellant, this Court is not inclined to allow the petition.

4. In the result, the petition stands dismissed.
