COMMON ORDER

[Made by R.VIJAYAKUMAR, J.]

These writ petitions have been filed seeking for a mandamus not to dispossess the petitioners from their properties in Survey No.143/1E, at Marungur Group Village, Thiruvadanai Taluk, Ramanthapuram District, wherein, they are in possession from the year 1982 onwards.

2. According to the petitioners, even in the representations sent by the petitioners on 11.04.2022, they have stated that the Revenue Authorities have illegally entered into the properties and taken possession on 08.04.2022.

3. The Revenue records filed along with the typed set of papers indicates that the petitioners were in possession of Survey No.143/2B and not in Survey No.143/1E. However, with some ulterior motive, the prayer has been sought for not to dispossess them from Survey No.143/1E without due process of law.

4. Learned Special Government Pleader appearing for the respondents pointed out that the petitioners were in possession of Government lands and that lands have been taken possession by the Government on 08.04.2022.

5. We find that there is no merit on these writ petitions and accordingly, these writ petitions stand dismissed. No costs.
