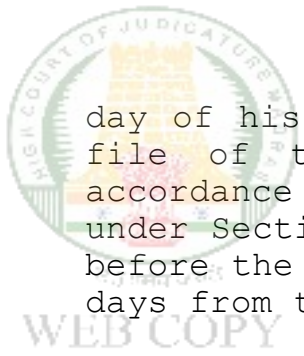
PRAYER: Criminal Original Petition filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C, to direct the District and Sessions Judge, Special Court for Trial of Cases registered under SC/ST (P.O.A) Act, 1989, Ramanathapuram, Ramanathapuram District to accept surrender of the petitioner and consider the petitioner's bail application and grant bail on the date of surrender himself, in Crime No.77 of 2022 on the file of the second respondent.

ORDER

This Criminal Original Petition is filed for a direction to direct the District and Sessions Judge, Special Court for Trial of Cases registered under SC/ST (P.O.A) Act, 1989, Ramanathapuram, Ramanathapuram District, to accept surrender of the petitioner and consider the petitioner's bail application and grant bail on the date of surrender himself, in Crime No.77 of 2022 on the file of the second respondent.

2. In view of the specific bar under Section 18 of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 and also taking into consideration the possibility of misusing the pious intention of the Parliament against innocent persons, there shall be a direction to the learned District and Sessions Judge Special Court for Trial of Cases registered under SC/ST (P.O.A) Act, 1989, Ramanathapuram, Ramanathapuram District, to consider the petitioners bail application, preferably on the same



day of his surrender in connection with Crime No.77 of 2022 on the file of the second respondent and pass appropriate orders in accordance with law after affording due opportunity to the victim under Section 15(a) of the SC/ST Act. The petitioner shall surrender before the concerned jurisdictional Court within a period of fifteen days from the date of the receipt of a copy of this Order.

3. It is needless to say that the Court below while disposing the bail petition shall look into the gravity of the offence, previous antecedents of the petitioner and pass orders. Mere direction issued by this Court to consider the bail petition on the same day does not amount to consider it favourably.

4. With the above direction, the Criminal Original Petition stands disposed of.
