ORDER

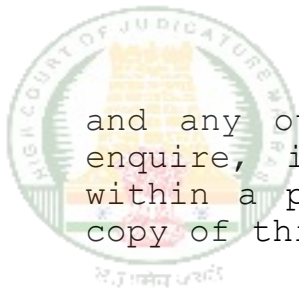

2. Heard Mr.B.Mahendrarajan, learned Counsel for the writ petitioner and Mr.J.John Rajadurai, learned Government Advocate, who accepts notice on behalf of the respondent.

3. The respondent has already issued a notice of enquiry on 17.02.2022 pursuant to the petition submitted by the petitioner.

4. No prejudice would be caused to the respondent or any other party, if a direction is given by this Court directing the respondent to pass final orders on the petition submitted by the petitioner within the time frame to be fixed by this Court.

5. For the foregoing reasons, this Court directs the respondent to pass final orders on the petition submitted by the petitioner dated 15.02.2022 seeking for cancellation of the Document Nos.695 of 1984 and 663 of 2001, after affording a fair hearing to the petitioner as well as the parties to the aforementioned documents



and any other necessary party, whom the respondent deems fit to enquire, including granting them the right of personal hearing, within a period of four (4) months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

6. With the above direction, this Writ Petition stands disposed of. There shall be no order as to costs.
