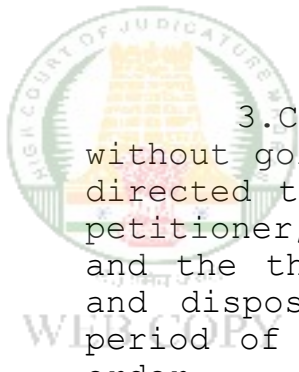

3.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, without going into the merits of the case, the second respondent is directed to conduct enquiry on the representation submitted by the petitioner, dated 23.04.2022 after issuing notice to the petitioner and the third respondent herein and other counter parties if any, and dispose the same on merits in accordance with law within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

4.With the above observations, this Writ Petition stands disposed of. No costs. Consequently connected miscellaneous petition is closed.
