The petitioner seeks production of the person of his daughter, namely, Nandhini, aged about 19 years. According to the petitioner, his daughter went missing on 10.02.2022. Apprehending that she has been kidnapped, the petitioner has come up with this Habeas Corpus Petition. He has also cited the private respondents 3 to 5 as the persons responsible for his daughter going missing.

2.Mr.A.Thiruvadikumar, learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondents 1 and 2, upon instructions, would



submit that the daughter of the petitioner has married the 5th respondent, namely, Arun and photographs of the marriage have also been produced.

3.In view of the said revelation, we do not think that there is any illegal custody involved as alleged by the petitioner. Hence, this Habeas Corpus Petition is dismissed.
