2. The petitioner's father died due to snake bite way back in the year 2010. Subsequently, his mother also passed away. The petitioner wants the respondents to pay compensation. The petitioner's request cannot be accepted for the simple reason that the petitioner's father was a pensioner. In any event in respect of the death that occurred way back in the year 2010, the question of



invoking writ jurisdiction under Article 226 of the Constitution of India does not arise at all. No case has been made out for granting relief.

3. This writ petition stands dismissed. No costs.
