COMMON ORDER

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and the application in I.A.No.1 of 2021 was filed only to amend the plaint as there is no legal heirs for the deceased second defendant in the suit and to that factual aspect alone, there was no dispute by the petitioner /defendant.

3. Therefore, there is no reason to interfere with the orders of this Court. It is always open to the petitioner to raise all his grounds in the trial Court.

4. Accordingly, these Review Applications are dismissed.
