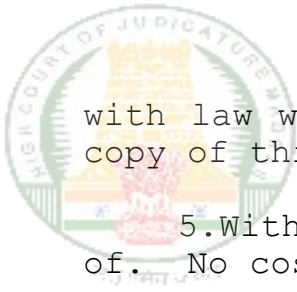
O R D E R

4.Considering the aforesaid submissions, the first respondent is directed to consider the petitioner's representation dated 25.04.2022 and pass appropriate orders on merits and in accordance



with law within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
