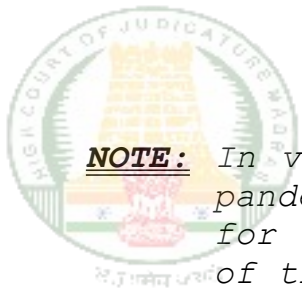
3.Recording the said submission of the learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side), this Writ Petition stands closed.
