2.Recording the endorsement made by the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner, this petition is dismissed as withdrawn.

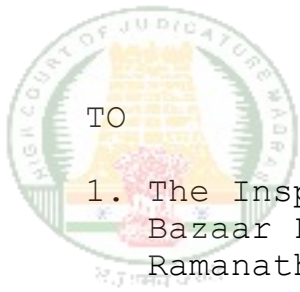
