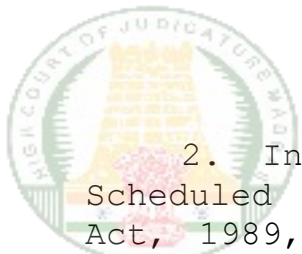

O R D E R

This Criminal Original Petition is filed for a direction to direct the learned District and Sessions Judge for exclusive trial of PCR Cases, (PCR Court), Pudukottai, to accept the surrender of the petitioners and consider their bail application on the same day on merits relating to the Crime No.164 of 2022 on the file of the second respondent police.



2. In view of the specific bar under Section 18 of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989, and also taking into consideration the possibility of misusing the pious intention of the Parliament against innocent persons, there shall be a direction to the learned District and Sessions Judge for exclusive trial of PCR Cases, (PCR Court), Pudukottai, to consider the petitioners' bail application, preferably on the same day of their surrender in connection with Crime No. 164 of 2022 on the file of the 2nd respondent and pass appropriate orders in accordance with law after affording due opportunity to the victim under Section 15(a) of the SC/ST Act. The petitioners shall surrender before the concerned jurisdictional Court within a period of fifteen days from the date of the receipt of a copy of this Order.

3. In view of the above, the Criminal Original Petition stands allowed.
