PRAYER :-

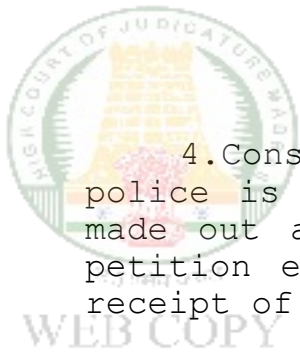
For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No. Not known of 2022 on the file of the respondent Police.
