PRAYER: Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India to issue a Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondents 1 and 2 to conduct survey and demarcate the boundaries of the land comprised in S.No.512/2C1B and Patta No.4560 to an extent of 0.1.51 Hectares of Uthappanayakkanur Village, Usilampatti Taluk, Madurai District within the stipulated time fixed by this Court.

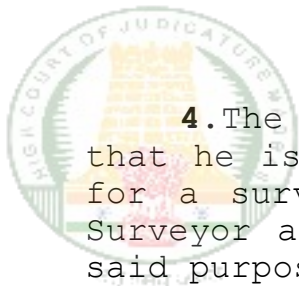

ORDER

This writ petition has been filed for a Mandamus seeking for a direction to the first and second respondents to survey and demarcate the boundaries in respect of the petitioner's land measuring 0.1.51 Hectares in Survey No.512/2C1B, Uthappanayakkanur Village, Usilampatti Taluk, Madurai District.

2.The petitioner has paid challan on 16.05.2022, seeking for survey and demarcation of boundaries in respect of the aforementioned property which he claims that it belongs to him absolutely. Since the said application has not been considered till date, this writ petition has been filed.

3.Heard Mr.SP.Vijay Nivas, learned Counsel for the writ petitioner and Mr.A.Kannan, learned Additional Government Pleader who accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.



4.The petitioner has produced documents in support of his case that he is the owner of the aforementioned property. He has sought for a survey and fixation of boundaries by the appointment of a Surveyor and the petitioner has paid challan on 21.03.2022 for the said purpose.

5.No prejudice would be caused to the respondents, if the survey and demarcation of the boundaries is done in the presence of the petitioner and any other necessary party, whom the respondents deem fit to put on notice at the time of survey.

6.Accordingly, this Court directs the first respondent to survey and fix the boundaries in the petitioner's property measuring 0.1.51 Hectares in Survey No.512/2C1B, Uthappanayakkanur Village, Usilampatti Taluk, Madurai District, after giving notice to the petitioner and any other necessary party, whom the first respondent deem fit to put on notice at the time of survey, within a period of twelve [12] weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

7.With the above direction, this Writ Petition stands disposed of. There shall be no order as to costs.
