**Prayer in CONT P(MD) . 31/ 2020 :**

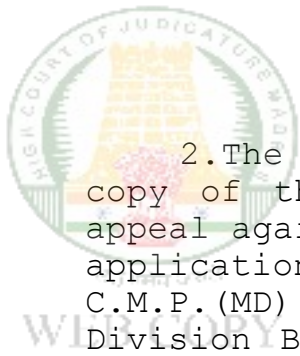

Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court To issue a Writ of Mandamus directing the respondent to award the petitioner one more mark for the Question No.97 in B Series in the TET Examination 2013 and thereby include the petitioner in the eligibility list and give appointment for the petitioner.

ORDER : This petition coming up for orders on this day, upon perusing the petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of MR.H.ARUMUGAM, Advocate for the petitioner and of MR.V.R.SHANMUGANATHAN, Standing Counsel on behalf of the Respondent, the court made the following order:-
