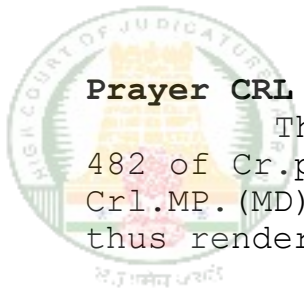
Prayer CRL MP(MD) . No.2801 of 2021:-
