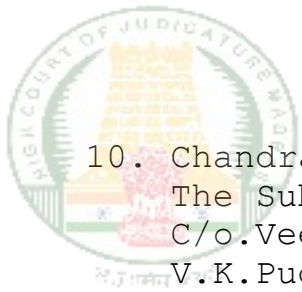

2. Accordingly, this Writ Petition is dismissed for non-prosecution. No costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petitions are closed.

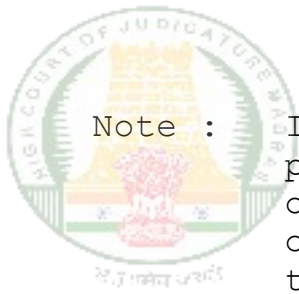
