ORDER

2.The only grievance of the petitioner is that in the show cause notice, the vehicle number has been mentioned, according to him, it is not belonged to him. Therefore, he sought to quash the entire show cause notice.

3.At the outset, I am unable to accept the contention. If at all the vehicle does not belong to the petitioner, he could give a proper explanation to the show cause notices to the Revenue



Divisional Officer. Without resorting such measure, as a matter of right, he cannot challenge the show cause notice. Accordingly, this Writ Petition stands dismissed. No costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petitions are closed.
