3.Recording the same, this criminal original petition is closed.

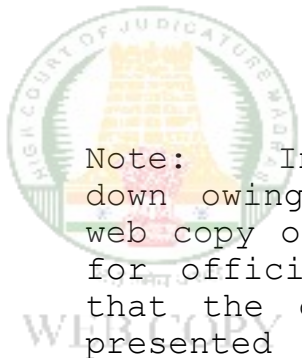
