2.In view of the submission made by the learned Additional Government Pleader appearing for the respondents, this Writ Petition is dismissed as infructuous. No costs.

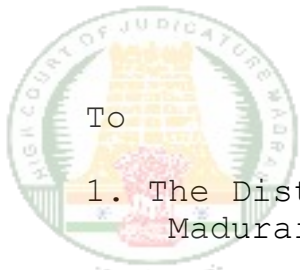
