The petitioner originally belongs to Andharapradesh. Because of the condition imposed upon him, he stayed here.



3. In view of the objection made by the learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side), I find no merit in this petition.

4. Accordingly, this Criminal Miscellaneous Petition is dismissed. The petitioner is directed to comply the condition passed by this Court in Crl.OP(MD)No.3770 of 2022 dated 29.04.2022 strictly.
