The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner has filed a petition under Section 156(3) Cr.P.C on 18.02.2022 before the Judicial Magistrate, Natham to direct the concerned police to register his complaint against the accused persons and the same was not taken on file so far. He further submitted that the on 18.02.2022, the learned Magistrate returned the petition for rectifying the some errors. After rectification, the petitioner has submitted his petition, again on 24.03.2022, the learned magistrate has returned the petition by stating that previous rectification are not yet rectified.
