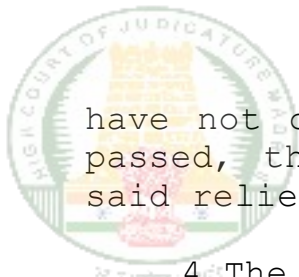

O R D E R

This writ petitioner filed this Writ Petition seeking for issuance of a Writ of Mandamus directing the second respondent to grant permission for conducting Vaigasi Pongal Thiruvizha festival grant permission and necessary protection to perform the cultural programs cultural programs including the dance program (Adal Padal) on 12.06.2022 at Thavasilingasamy Thirukovil, Athangaraipatti village, Peraiyur Taluk, Madurai District.

2.The learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) takes notice for the respondents. By consent, this writ petition is taken up for final disposal at the admission stage itself.

3.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that Vaigasi Pongal Thiruvizha for the temple, by name, Thavasilingasamy Thirukovil, Athangaraipatti village, Peraiyur Taluk, Madurai District is going to be held in the month of Vaigasi. Subsequent to the same, in order to conduct a cultural programme on 12.06.2022, they sought permission of the police by

4. The learned Government Advocate (criminal side) appearing for the respondent police would submit that the respondents have received the representation of the petitioner and the same is pending for consideration.

It is brought to the notice of this Court that the Director General of Police, Tamil Nadu, Chennai had issued a circular memorandum in Rc.007301/Genl.I (1)/2019, dated 09.04.2019, along with instructions to the Inspectors of Police throughout Tamil Nadu for consideration of applications seeking permission for conducting cultural programme. Therefore, in view of the detailed circular and guidelines issued by the Director General of Police, the respondent police is hereby directed to consider the representation of the petitioner, dated 06.06.2022 and pass suitable orders based on the above said circular.

7. With the above direction, this writ petition is disposed of. No cost.
