PRAYER: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court to issue a Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondents herein to grant permission and give police protection to conduct the "Adal Padal Programme" dance program at about 7.00 p.m. on 13.06.2022 in pursuance to the festival of "Arulmigu Sri Muthumariamman Thirukovil", situated in Neivathali, Aranthangi Taluk, Pudukkottai District, by considering the petitioner's representation dated 08.06.2022.

O R D E R

This writ petitioner filed this Writ Petition seeking for issuance of a Writ of Mandamus directing the respondents herein to grant permission and give police protection to conduct the "Adal Padal Programme" dance program at about 7.00 p.m. on 13.06.2022 in pursuance to the festival of "Arulmigu Sri Muthumariamman Thirukovil", situated in Neivathali, Aranthangi Taluk, Pudukkottai District by considering the petitioner's representation dated 08.06.2022.

2.The learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) takes notice for the respondents. By consent, this writ petition is taken up for final disposal at the admission stage itself.

3.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that 9th day Mandagapadi Festival for the temple, by name, Arulmigu Sri Muthumariamman Thirukovil situated at Neivathali, Aranthangi Taluk, Pudukkottai District is going to be held on 13.06.2022. Subsequent to the same, in order to conduct a cultural programme, they sought permission of the police by giving representations dated



30.05.2022 and 08.06.2022. But, the respondents have not considered the said representation. Since no order was passed, the petitioner has come before this Court for the above said relief.

4.The learned Government Advocate (criminal side) appearing for the respondent police would submit that the respondents have received the representations of the petitioner and the same is pending for consideration.

5.I have considered the submission of the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate (criminal side) appearing for the respondent police.

6.It is brought to the notice of this Court that the Director General of Police, Tamil Nadu, Chennai had issued a circular memorandum in Rc.007301/Genl.I (1)/2019, dated 09.04.2019, along with instructions to the Inspectors of Police throughout Tamil Nadu for consideration of applications seeking permission for conducting cultural programme. Therefore, in view of the detailed circular and guidelines issued by the Director General of Police, the respondent police is hereby directed to consider the representation of the petitioner, dated 08.06.2022 and pass suitable orders based on the above said circular.

7.With the above direction, this writ petition is disposed of. No cost.
