period of four weeks from the date of this order, after deducting the amount already deposited by him, to the credit of M.C.O.P.No.13 of 2020, on the file of the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal - Principal District Judge, Ramanathapuram, failing which, interim stay granted shall stand automatically dismissed.

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2. This Petition is allowed accordingly.
